

**TOWN OF LANIGAN  
BYLAW 5/2019**

**A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW 2/2004 A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF  
LANIGAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROHIBITION OF DANGEROUS  
DOGS AND THE REGULATIONS AND CONTROL OF ALL OTHER DOGS  
INCLUDING LICENSING, RUNNING AT LARGE AND IMPOUNDING.**



The Council of the Town of Lanigan in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

That Bylaw 2/2004 respecting the prohibition of dangerous dogs and the regulation and control of all other dogs including licensing, running at large and impounding is amended:

- 1) By REMOVING from Section 2:  
“g) “RUNNING AT LARGE” shall mean off the premises of the owner and not on a leash and/or not in the immediate and continuous effective control of a competent person”
  
- 2) By ADDING to Section 2:  
“g) “AT LARGE” means if the animal is off the premises of its owner, unless the animal is both on a leash, not exceeding 2.0 m, and is under proper control;”
  
- 3) By REPLACING in every instance of the bylaw “running at large” with “at large”
